8th Grade Graduation Information

Graduation is just around the corner. As you begin your own preparation for the end of the year graduation activities, please know that <u>the earliest we can notify the 8th graders of their graduation status is WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON, JUNE 3rd</u>. Recognizing this last minute notice makes it difficult for you to plan your own family celebrations; our recommendation is that, if there is any doubt in your child being able to graduate, you not invest a lot of money in clothing or a party.

Also, please know 8th graders will be measured for their graduation gowns this month. Please make sure your 8th grader is at school on that day.

Parent Portal Sign Ups

Willows Intermediate School is changing the process for back-to-school paperwork for the 2020-2021 school year. We will no longer mail home the forms that need to be completed and the documents that outline school and district policies and procedures. All information will now be completed and reviewed online through the Student Data Confirmation Process. *In order to complete this process, you must have a WUSD Parent Portal account for your Willows Intermediate School student*. If you have another WUSD student, you can have one Parent Portal account that is associated with multiple students.

<u>For Parents/Guardians that currently have a parent portal account:</u> Please verify that you know your log-in information. If not, you may need to reset your password. If you have another child that needs to be added to an already existing account, please contact the WIS office to receive the required codes.

<u>For Parents/Guardians that do not have a parent portal account:</u> If you currently <u>do</u> <u>not</u> have a portal account, here is the website to go to create an account: <u>portal.willowsunified.org/Student/LoginParent.aspx</u>

You will need to contact the school office to receive your student's required codes.

Creating a parent portal account <u>does</u> require that you have a current email address. If you do not currently have an email, there are several websites that allow for the creation of a free account. We recommend G-mail and it is available in the App Store. The Aeries Parent Portal App is also available on the App Store and the process can be completed on a smartphone.

If you need help creating your parent portal account and e-mail, you may come to the Willows Intermediate School on March 4th, from 3-6pm in the WIS computer lab, Room 106. A translator will be available.

In order for your Willows Intermediate School student(s) to receive their class assignment for the 2020-2021 school year, you will need to set up your parent portal account no later than *March 31st, 2020.*

Immunization Requirement - Incoming 7th Graders

Parents: Please remember that all 6th graders will need to have a Tdap (pertussis) vaccine prior to July 1st for the 20-21 school year, per the new state law. Please bring or mail in your child's immunization record showing that the Tdap requirement is met, <u>by May 1st</u>. We regret that your child will not be able to start school for the 2020-2021 school year without meeting this new requirement. Contact your doctor to get the required vaccine or documentation.
